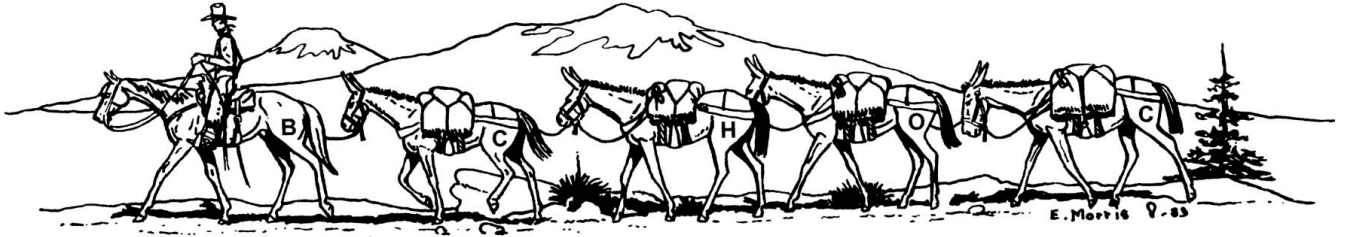


BCHC Membership



Back in 1981 a group of private and commercial packers met to form the **High Sierra Stock Users Association (HSSUA)** with the purpose of representing horsemen in dealings with the administrators of public lands.

Five years later the HSSUA joined with Montana, Idaho, and Washington to form an affiliation called the **Back Country Horsemen of America (BCHA)**. The national organization's task is to coordinate activities of the various state backcountry organizations. The BCHA now has BCH organizations in 13 states throughout the country.

The HSSUA adopted the name **Backcountry Horsemen of California (BCHC)** in order to conform to the national name and to better reflect its growing statewide membership.

BCHC now has a membership that totals nearly 4,000 men and women, most of whom are affiliated with one of our 26 units.
