The Boden Canyon - Orosco Ridge areas of the Cleveland National Forest near Ramona are in jeopardy of being closed to sportsmen. Over the years, the area has been used as a target shooting site and local dump, resulting in an area that more resembles a war zone than a National Forest. The Forest Service is concerned that the site, which is strewn with targets, brass, engine blocks and other trash can potentially cause a hazardous situation for those of us who want to use and enjoy the area.

Hunters, shooters, hikers, equestrians and concerned sportsmen must take note that if we do not address the situation soon, the Forest Service will take action and we may not approve of their solutions.

Please join the San Diego Chapter members in an effort to clean up Boden Canyon and Orosco Ridge on Saturday, February 17 at 9:00 a.m. at the Gaging Station off of Pamo Road. The Forest Service requires that all volunteers sign in on cleanup day, be dressed in long pants, long sleeved shirts, work boots, hats, gloves and use eye protection. The San Diego Chapter and Forest Service will provide rakes, trash bags, and heavy equipment to aid in the effort. The San Diego Chapter will provide water, juice and snacks. We are expecting a strong turnout and extensive media coverage of the event.
